

Importing Configurations Mindray ePM Patient Monitor

How to download ePM Standard configurations from the Mindray UK website:

- Visit www.mindrayuk.com/education
- Find the ePM Standard Configuration zip file and download onto a PC. Please note an encrypted USB stick cannot be used
- Unzip the file and copy the **mrbigdipercfg** folder and the **mrbigdiperUser** folder to a USB stick

To import the configuration from the USB drive to the monitor, follow this procedure:

- Turn the ePM patient monitor on with power key
- Connect the USB drive to the monitor's USB port on the back of the monitor
- Select the **Main Menu** quick key




- Swipe with 2 fingers to the **Configuration** column → select **Manage**





- Input the password **315666** and select


- Ensure the monitor shows **General**, Default Patient Category is **Adult** and Default Use EWS is **Yes**

- Select **Import Configuration** → select **User Maintenance Settings, ePM Standard (Adult), ePM Standard (Ped)** and **ePM Standard (Neo)** → select **Import** → select **Back**



- In the **Manage Configuration** menu choose **Select Default Config** → select **Load Specified Config**



- Press the area labelled **Factory Default** located next to **Default Adult Config / Default Ped Config / Default Neo Config** → select **ePM Standard** for each of the three patient categories (Adult, Ped and Neo)
- Press **'X'** to exit menu



- Select **Alarm Setup** key

See image below:




- Turn the device off


